In mid August the Fishing vessel Windy Bay sank in Prince Williams Sound spilling an estimated 35,000 gallons of diesel into the pristine waters.



By late August the State of Alaska had spent over \$ 3 million to clean up the spill and its effects on the surrounding shore line. That is \$ 85/gallon, pretty expensive diesel.

All marine vessels operating in US waters should be required to use F-T or biodegradable synthetic diesel.
